Chairman Sorensen presented a request for approval of a County-wide Reciprocal Reporting Agreement – Sheriff's Department.

Mr. Pablo Eves, First Assistant State's Attorney, Civil Division, stated that there are two changes on page 5 of the Agreement, which is page 69 of the Packet. He advised that a bill passed last week, Public Act 9861, changes the definition of a delinquent minor to "persons under 18 years of age" and not "17 years of age." Mr. Eves pointed out that the changes are under Sections c) and d).
