Minutes of the Liquor Control Commission

The Liquor Control Commission of the McLean County Board met on Tuesday, December 15, 2009 at 10:08 a.m. in Room 400, Government Center, 115 E. Washington Street, Bloomington, Illinois.

Chairman Sorensen called the meeting to order at 10:07 a.m. He noted that the first item for action is approval of the minutes from the October 13, 2009 Liquor Control Commission Meeting.

Motion by Hoselton/Cavallini to recommend approval of the October 13, 2009 Liquor Control Commission Minutes.
Motion carried.

Chairman Sorensen stated that the Commission has one item for action. Chairman Sorensen turned the meeting over to Mr. Pablo Eves First Assistant State's Attorney.

Mr. Eves stated he had one case pending before the Commission:

1. Hearing on the Merits of County vs. Oren R. Graybill/DBA Lake Road Inn.

Mr. Eves acknowledged the owner and license holder, Mr. Oren R. Graybill was present at the Liquor Control Commission meeting. He distributed an Amended Stipulation of Facts noting that the only change is the date of the STEPS Program has been moved from December 2009 to February of 2010 due to the program schedule. Mr. Eves advised that Mr. Graybill and the State's Attorney Office have entered into the amended written stipulation of facts, involving the sale of alcoholic beverages to a Minor (person under the age of 21) on September 23, 2009 at approximately 6:48 p.m., at the premises known as Lake Road Inn, 25160 N. 1750 East Road, Hudson. This is not a contested hearing, Mr. Graybill, in behalf of Lake Road Inn admits to the charge.

Mr. Eves state that because Mr. Graybill, in his capacity as the owner of the Lake Road Inn, has not had any liquor violations, it is the recommendation of both the States' Attorneys Office

and Mr. Graybill that the Stipulation of facts be admitted into evidence and that Mr. Graybill or his designated representative of the Lake Road Inn, Ms. Tracy Johnson, be required to enroll, attend, and successfully complete the STEPS Program. Mr. Eves stated that this is Mr. Graybill's first offence and no fine is being asked for at this time. He explained to the Commission that the STEPS Program is a program conducted by the Normal Police Department and Project Oz. The program is intended to educate bar owners and employees in identifying fake ID's and is designed to help prevent underage drinking and DUI's.

Mr. Cavallini asked if the STEPS program is a continuing program. Mr. Eves responded that it is a progressive discipline program likened to traffic safety school. Any further violations would result in an additional fine plus further education.

Mrs. Bostic asked if the underage buyer presented any identification. Mr. Graybill stated that the underage buyer did present an ID, however it was simply misread. Mr. Eves added that there was not a fake ID used.

Chairman Sorensen asked for a motion to enter an order consistent with the recommendations of the State's Attorney and the Lake Road Inn.

Motion by Hoselton/Bostic to recommend approval of the Amended Stipulation of facts and direct Chairman Sorensen to sign the Order LV-09-1, issuing the requirement of Mr. Oren Graybill, owner of Lake Road Inn or a representative to enroll, attend, and successfully complete the STEPS Program.
Motion carried.

A signed copy of Order LV-09-1, the County of McLean vs. Oren R. Graybill DBA/Lake Road Inn., was given to Mr. Graybill.

Chairman Sorensen asked if the Commission had any further business. Hearing none, he adjourned the meeting at 10:13 a.m.
