Minutes of the Liquor Control Commission

The Liquor Control Commission of the McLean County Board met on Tuesday, June 17, 2014 at 11:43 a.m. in Room 404, Government Center, 115 E. Washington Street, Bloomington, Illinois.

Chairman Sorensen called the meeting to order 11:43 a.m. He noted that the first item for action is approval of the minutes from the April 15, 2014 Liquor Control Commission Meeting. Chairman Sorensen asked if there were any additions or corrections to the minutes. Hearing none he approved as presented without objection.

Chairman Sorensen continued with the Request for Approval of the Annual Liquor License Renewals for 2014-2015. He referred to the list of applicants and the current McLean County Liquor Control Ordinance. He suggested that the list reflect Graybill Limited as Lake Road Inn. Video Gaming also needs to be updated. He asked if the Video Gaming license is relevant to the Liquor License. Mr. Mark Messman, Assistant State's Attorney, responded that Video Gaming is not part of the Liquor License application.

Mr. Messman stated that he has reviewed all of the applications that were filed with the McLean County Clerk. He noted that 13 Annual Liquor Licenses were issued in 2013-2014. All 13 license holders have filed for renewal. There were six Outdoor Garden Licenses issued in 2013-2014. All six license holders have filed for renewal

Mr. Messman assured the Committee that all the applications received are in order with license fees paid and all documentation papers in order. All licenses will expire June 30, 2014. He reported that there have been no violations in 2013-2014. There has been one change of ownership presented to the Commission in April, 2014. Mr. Messman recommended the approval of the following 2013-2014 County Liquor Licenses:

In addition to the regular premise license, six establishments have re-applied for a Class "G" Outdoor Garden license. Those establishments are:

2. Indian Springs Recreation
3. Hazy Hills Golf Course
4. LeRoy County Club
5. Mustang Sally's Group LLC
6. White Oak Vineyard

Mr. Messman recommended approval of the re-applications for a Class "G" Outdoor Garden license as well.

Chairman Sorensen asked if there were any questions regarding these applications. Hearing none, he asked for a motion to approve the 2014 - 2015 liquor licenses.

Ms. Metsker asked when the change in ownership of the Danvers Y took place. Mr. Messman responded that ownership took place before the 2013-2014 license renewal. She asked if there have been any issues with the new owner. Mr. Messman stated that there have not been any violations at the Danvers Y in the past 12 months.

Chairman Sorensen added that there have been frequent visits to the Danvers Y by the County Sheriff's Department.

Ms. Brandt stated that she thought the Danvers Y was owned by John Irwin. Mr. Messman stated that ownership was required to be transferred after the incident two years ago. The current owner is John D. Irwin, the son.

Motion by Wendt/ Cavallini to recommend approval of the Renewal of all 2013-2014 Annual Liquor Licenses along with the Class "G" Outdoor Garden License to Crestwicke Country Club, Indian Springs Recreation, Hazy Hills Golf Course, Mustang Sally's Group, LLC, LeRoy County Club and White Oak Vineyards.

Chairman Sorensen asked if there was any further business to come before the Liquor Control Commission. Hearing none he adjourned the Liquor Control Commission Meeting at 10:50 a.m.
