The attached document contains blanks that will, as result of the discussions and actions taken in Rules Subcommittee on May 6, 2021, be filled in and provided to the Executive Committee for their consideration on Monday, May 10, 2021.

Please note that Rule 20-2 and 20-4 contain dated language that should be updated regardless of the number of districts and number of members.

§ 20-1 Size of Board. (If Necessary)

The McLean County Board, hereinafter called "the Board," shall be comprised of 20 members.

§ 20-2Board districts.

[Amended 2-17-2015]

For the purpose of electing members of the Board in 2002 2022 and in succeeding years until the County is again reapportioned, the County of McLean is reapportioned into 40 districts, with two Board members to be elected from each district.

§ 20-4Terms of office.

The terms of office of County Board members shall commence on the first Monday of the month following the month of their election to the Board. Twenty members shall be elected on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November of 2002 2022. Ten members, ene of such members being from each district, shall serve a term of two years, and each district, shall serve a term of four years. Their successors shall serve terms of four years. The identity of those members serving the respective two- and four-year terms shall be determined by lot among the members, said lots to be drawn at 9:00 a.m. on the first Monday in December 2002 2022 in the room in which County Board meetings are regularly held. The McLean County Clerk holding office at that time shall supervise said drawing.

§ 20-7Legal descriptions of Board Districts. (If Necessary) [Amended 2-17-2015]

The County Administrator and First Civil Assistant State's Attorney are hereby directed to prepare complete legal descriptions of the 10 County Board districts. The legal descriptions of the County Board Districts shall be filed with the County Clerk's Office and with the City of Bloomington Election Commission.
