Effective March 16, 2020 – April 10, 2020 - In the Eleventh Judicial Circuit Courts, consisting of the counties of Ford, Livingston, Logan, McLean and Woodford, the only cases which will be heard will be criminal felonies, bond hearings, juvenile abuse/neglect, juvenile delinquency cases, petitions to rescind summary suspension and any other emergency hearings as they may arise. **If you do not have a case in one of these categories, please do not come to court.**
