



FOIA Fees

1. Coroner's Office (55 ILCS 5/4-7001):
 - a. Transcript of Sworn Testimony \$5.00/page
 - b. Autopsy Report \$50.00/copy
 - c. Coroner's Jury Verdict Statement \$5.00/copy
 - d. Toxicology Report \$25.00/copy
 - e. Autopsy/Crime Scene Photos \$3.00/photo
 - f. Miscellaneous Reports \$25.00/copy
 - Examples:
 - Coroner Ruling – Manner of Death Determination
 - Coroner's Initial Report

2. Sheriff's Department (625 ILCS 5/11-416):
 - a. Crash Report with Crash Reconstruction \$20.00/copy
 - b. Crash Report without Crash Reconstruction \$5.00/copy

3. Production Fees (5 ILCS 140/6(a), 5 ILCS 140/6(a-5), 5 ILCS 140/6(b)):
 - a. Paper – first fifty (50) pages free, then \$0.15/page
 - b. Record Certification \$1.00/quantity
 - c. USB varies
 - d. CD/DVD varies
 - e. Non-PDF Data (voluminous requests only):
 - Not more than 2 megabytes \$20.00/quantity
 - More than 2 but not more than 4 megabytes \$40.00/quantity
 - More than 4 megabytes \$100.00/quantity
 - f. PDF Data (voluminous requests only):
 - Not more than 80 megabytes \$20.00/quantity
 - More than 80 but not more than 160 megabytes \$40.00/quantity
 - More than 160 megabytes \$100.00/quantity

4. Labor Fees (commercial requests only) (5 ILCS 140/6(f)):
 - a. First eight (8) hours spent searching for and redacting responsive documents are done without charge, thereafter \$10.00/hour

Other fees may be charged pursuant to statute.

For any request that incurs a fee, an invoice will be sent prior to the records being released.
